

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All students are expected to wear school uniform and to be smart in appearance. It would be sensible for all clothing to be marked clearly with the owner's name.

Extremes of fashion, such as skinny jeans/chinos, as well as excessively long (or short) hair, are not acceptable.

YEARS 7 – 11

Navy Blazer, Main School House Badge and Tie,
Black 'V' necked pullover *without* emblem.
(Jumpers should only be worn under blazers and not instead of blazers)

YEARS 12 – 13

Black Blazer
(Navy Blazer may continue to be worn until replacement is necessary),
Sixth Form House Badge and Tie,
Black 'V' necked pullover *without* emblem.
(Jumpers should only be worn under blazers and not instead of blazers)

WHOLE SCHOOL (Years 7 – 13)

Black/Charcoal Grey Trousers,
White School Shirt – NOT fashion shirt or sports shirt.
Black shoes, Dark Socks.

NO rings, earrings or other forms of jewellery.

Belts, if worn, should be plain black with no fashion buckle.

NO earphones to be visible around school.

Mobile phones are not to be used, seen or heard during the school day.

Hair is neither excessively long (over the collar) nor excessively short,
is clean and well groomed and of one natural colour.

Extremes of fashion are to be avoided.

Coats must be taken off when inside the school building (including the Lunch Hall).

Simple Rule: WHEN IN – COATS OFF

Blazers are to be worn around the School – that is the norm.

Teachers may allow their removal during lesson time.
