

GCSE Results Day Guidelines

- TBGS results will be available for collection from the Sixth Form Centre from approximately 9.00am, Thursday 22 August.
- Please go to the appropriate room to collect your results:
 - Burgh SF1
 - Dart SF1
 - Fox Tor SF3
 - Goodrington Common Room (near end)
 - Haldon Common Room (far end)
 - Rougemont Sixth Form Café
- **Successful applicants to the Sixth Form who took their GCSEs at Torquay Boys'** will receive a letter with their results slip, explaining what to do next.
- **Successful applicants to the Sixth Form from schools other than Torquay Boys'** are asked to come to the Sixth Form Centre between 9am and 11am Friday 23 August with their results slip.
- **If you applied to join our Sixth Form but no longer intend to,** we would be grateful if you would let us know so that we can allocate your place to someone else (email: jbainbridge@tbgs.torbay.sch.uk).
- **If you have achieved at least 36 points in the relevant subjects* and the required grade in your chosen Sixth Form subjects,** congratulations! We look forward to welcoming you to the Sixth Form at 08.45am, Tuesday 3 September. There will be a notice in Main Reception and in the Sixth Form Centre telling you where to find your Tutor Room. Don't forget to buy your Sixth Form tie & badge from the online school shop <https://app.parentpay.com/ParentPayShop/Uniform/Default.aspx?shopid=169> at a total cost of £14. This will be handed out on the first day (which is a non-uniform day).
- **If you have achieved at least 36 points in the relevant subjects* but have now changed your mind about your subject choice,** please try to see Mr Bainbridge as soon as possible to discuss alternative options. You may wish to discuss these first with Caroline Shimmin (Independent Careers Adviser) who will be in the Sixth Form Centre (Thursday 25 August).
- **If you have achieved at least 36 points in the relevant subjects* but have not got the required grade in one or more of your chosen subjects,** don't panic. It may still be possible to accommodate you. Please see Mr Bainbridge as soon as possible. You may wish to discuss alternative options first with Caroline Shimmin (Independent Careers Adviser).
- **If you have not achieved at least 36 points in the relevant subjects*,** then it is unlikely that you will be able to join the Sixth Form here, but see Mr Bainbridge if you would like to discuss the matter further. You may wish to talk to Caroline Shimmin (Independent Careers Adviser) about alternatives.
